GREATER EURASIA: BUILDING DIALOGUE IN THE AGE OF UNCERTAINTY

The continent with 60% of Earth's population and that generates 65% of the global economy is in the midst of deep geopolitical conflicts that could have a dangerous impact on all humanity. Even though Eurasia has always been a space of permanent confrontations, today, security threats are on the rise amid the war in Ukraine, fragile recovery from the Covid-19 pandemic, rising economic disruption, and international organizations' decreased authority for conflict resolution. What is the future of Eurasia in the context of current conflicts and geopolitical shifts? Is there a way for the East and West to rebuild trust, and what role can Central Asia play in this process?
